The **student** and the **project coordinator** hereby agree on the following terms:

The course is free of charge for the **student**: it is funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union. Course funds are therefore covered by European taxpayers.

The course is structured in:

- preliminary online orientation (June 2016);
- a 10 day residential seminar (5<sup>th</sup> -15<sup>th</sup> July 2016, Montespertoli, Italy);
- an E-learning course of 10 Modules for a total of 200 hours;
- 80 hours of training experience (in student's local environment);
- periodic online tutoring and supervision support;

for the achievement of the MARS specialization certificate for psychosocial music support in deprived and marginalised communities.

The **student** agrees to:

- participate in preliminary online orientation;
- attend the residential seminar for the complete period of 10 days;
- complete all 10 E-learning modules;
- provide official evidence of training experience, including written documentation.

The **student** is aware that withdrawal from the course constitutes a factor of instability for the learning group and a threat to the full realization of the MARS project, negatively affecting the **project coordinator** and all project partner.

The **project coordinator** agrees to:

- advise the **student** in good time of any changes in the course calendar;
- guarantee the course contents;
- guarantee adequate support from course staff;
- oversee the final evaluation process;
- consign the MARS specialization certificate, Open Badges and ECVET validation on completion of the course.
